Interdisciplinary Learning: Art and Design and History

S2 The Industrial Revolution

Pupils learnt about the impact of industry on the rural landscape through looking at paintings and drawings created at the time of the Industrial Revolution and progressing to the present day.

The shape of factory and ceramic kilns chimneys were related to the shape of bottles which were used to improve skills on elliptical drawing and tonal painting.

Pupils used these to support their ideas for a paper collage of an industrial townscape.

The idea of a piece of work created by a production line was developed by the pupils sharing a year group task of designing two textile printed banners using individual lino cuts to make the images and linking them into a uniform design. These textile prints were embellished by pupils using threads and other materials. The banners will be displayed in the school in the future.
